<b>Tasting Notes:</b>	Dusty notes of cherry pie, cola, strawberry, rose petal, charcoal and sage. The mid palate shows polished and ripe flavors of black raspberry, wild berry, mocha, bittersweet chocolate and a hint of plum on the well structured finish.
